

Eargle-Millman Family Scholarship

Amount: \$1,000 DEADLINE: February 12, 2024

The Eargle-Millman Family Scholarship was founded in 2023 by Lucinda Eargle Millman and her husband, David Millman. Mrs. Millman, along with her parents, Eddie and Stella Eargle, and siblings, Jason and Kristina, are graduates of Pelion High School. The Eargle-Millman family wish to award scholarship assistance to Pelion High School graduates who are pursuing a 4-year college degree in business or business-related studies.

Scholarship Criteria & Selection Process

The Eargle-Millman Family Scholarship will be awarded each year to one Pelion High School senior who has met the following qualifying criteria:

- 1) Lexington District One Pelion High School senior who will graduate in May of the current school year.
- 2) Earned a minimum PHS GPA of 3.0 (or equivalent B) average is required in high school coursework.
- 3) Student has been accepted and committed to attend a four-year, accredited college immediately upon graduation in order to pursue a college degree in a declared business* or business-related major.

Acceptable majors include the following:

- Accounting
- Business
- Business Entrepreneurship
- Economics
- Finance
- International Business
- Marketing
- Management
- Human Resource Management
- Operations Management
- Operations & Supply Chain
- Real Estate
- Risk Management & Insurance

Note: College degree should also reflect a Bachelor of Arts in Business Administration or comparable degree.

In the event that multiple students qualify, selection will be made on the basis of the highest-ranking GPA. If a second tie-breaker is needed, due to more than one student with the same qualifications and same GPA, the SAT or ACT score can be used as the deciding factor.

Applicants will be selected by a Lexington One Educational Foundation Scholarship Committee based on information included in the scholarship application. The scholarship winner will be announced at the Pelion High School Awards Ceremony in the spring, so all applicants must plan to attend this school event.

Application Requirements / How to Apply

1. Complete the scholarship application questionnaire.
2. Request an official high school transcript from the Pelion High School Counseling Office staff to be included in the scholarship application packet, which includes SAT and/or ACT scores.
3. Submit all requested information to the PHS Counseling Office on or before the deadline.
4. Plan to attend the PHS Awards Ceremony that is scheduled in the spring.

Eargle-Millman Scholarship Award Process: At the PHS Awards Program the scholarship recipient will receive an award letter that includes an Educational Foundation Scholarship Agreement Form. **This form must be signed and returned to the Lexington One Educational Foundation in order for checks to be processed in July and November (\$500 each).** Checks are made payable to the chosen college/university and the scholarship recipient.

In order for the scholarship recipient to receive the scholarship award both semesters, the recipient must: 1) maintain a 3.0 GPA in college; 2) be enrolled as a full-time student (typically 12+ credit hours) at an accredited, 4-year institution of higher education; 3) remain a declared business major and 3) submit an official college transcript to the Educational Foundation staff immediately upon the completion of each semester.

Upon verification of scholarship requirements listed above, the student will be eligible to receive the \$500 scholarship award for the following semester.
