The scholarship committee will base the award on the following criteria:

- Financial Need (20 points)
- Essay on Agriculture (10 points)
- Extracurricular activities and community involvement (30 points)
- Personal analysis and interview (40 points)
- Interview (if needed for tie-breaker) will be scheduled in April of the current school year

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Complete the required information on pages 1 & 2 of the application.
2. Write a paragraph not more than one (1) page giving your reasons for pursuing a college degree in the field of agriculture.
3. Include an official high school transcript that contains your grades, courses, rank and test scores.
4. Include at least two letters of recommendation from citizens of the community other than relatives.
5. Include a separate, one-page résumé that contains the following:
 - Career Goals; past or present employment; and honors or awards received in extracurricular activities such as athletics, dramatics, clubs, community projects, etc. Indicate your membership in honor societies or other organizations and list any offices held.

Please return your completed application along with the required letters of recommendation to your FFA advisor by the deadline.

Applications are due **February 12, 2024.**
