



## **Sale-Cromer Memorial Scholarship Application**

**Deadline: February 12, 2024**

**Scholarship Amount: \$3,000**

#### **Scholarship Selection Process**

Preference will be given to LHS students who are in need of financial support and who would be hard-pressed to attend a college or university without outside financial assistance. Top candidates will be required to submit documentation of financial need including parents' assets prior to the required top candidates interview session.

All applications will be reviewed and then ranked by a Lexington One Educational Foundation Scholarship committee. Top candidates will be required to be interviewed on a chosen date. The Scholarship Award will be announced at the high school awards ceremony in spring of current school year.

#### **How to Apply**

1. Complete the scholarship application and essay questions.
2. Request official high school transcript and copy of test scores from LHS Counseling to be included in application packet.
3. Secure and submit two letters of recommendation from a teacher from a major academic subject and an employer or leader in a community organization who knows student well.
4. Must be willing to be interviewed by Scholarship Committee on chosen date and time.
5. Must attend the LHS Awards Night that is scheduled in spring if selected for the scholarship.
6. Must submit all requested information to the LHS Counseling office on or before the deadline.

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#### **How Scholarship is Awarded**

Upon award notification, recipient must sign and return the enclosed Foundation Scholarship Agreement Form to the Lexington One Educational Foundation in order for scholarship checks to be processed.

Each \$1,500 scholarship payment will be mailed directly to the chosen college or university with award winner's name indicated on the check in July and November of year awarded.
