- An official transcript
- Response to the questions below

Along with the completed application form, on a separate piece of paper briefly respond to two of the following four questions or statements:

- How does a positive attitude help someone during difficult times in his or her life?
- Curtis G. Bell always “cheered for the team.” What do you think that statement means and how do you “cheer for the team”?
- When you are faced with a difficult situation or a decision, how do you respond?
- Describe a difficult situation you have encountered and the steps you took to overcome that situation.

The scholarship award will be paid directly to the selected award winner's college or university and include the student's college identification number on it.
