



## Elsie Rast Stuart Scholarship

**Deadline April 1, 2026**

**Scholarship Amount: \$500**

The Elsie Rast Stuart Scholarship shall be awarded each year to a qualifying senior at Pelion High School who, by April 1<sup>st</sup> of that year, has achieved the highest score on the mathematical section of the SAT or ACT. In addition to the SAT/ACT score requirement, the qualifying student must meet at least one of the following three requirements:

1. Be in the top 30% of his/her graduating class
2. Have at least a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale
3. Have a combined score of at least 1100 on the SAT or a 22 on the ACT

In the event that the SAT or ACT changes its current numerical scoring system during the life of this trust, then an overall SAT or ACT score at or above the 80<sup>th</sup> percentile shall also qualify.

In event that two or more students have the same highest mathematical score or on the SAT or the ACT, the maximum scholarship amount shall be divided equally among them.

This is not a renewable scholarship. The check for this scholarship shall be paid directly to the student's college of choice and shall be designated to be used for tuition and/or required course materials.

No application is required, as the Pelion High School Counseling Office determines the scholarship winner based solely on the established criteria.

Upon award notification, the scholarship recipient should provide the following to the Educational Foundation Staff:

- 1) Contact information including personal cell and email
- 2) College attending and intended college major
- 3) High school transcript and high school resume.

This information will be shared with the scholarship donor.
