



Rooms to GROW: 2022 Dorm Room Grants & Academic Supplement Grants

The Educational Foundation's Board of Directors established this grant program to assist Lexington District One students with typical college expenses needed for residential college students. The Foundation will provide \$300 grants to help 25 high school seniors purchase basic dorm room supplies. This year, each applicant will also be considered for a one-time, \$500 academic supplement that should be used for tuition, fees or books. The program gives preference to college-bound students who have excelled despite sometimes overwhelming financial disadvantages.

Eligibility and Application Deadline: Applicants must be planning to attend a college, university, or technical college and live on campus. Grants are intended to place money in the hands of seniors who need it most.

Therefore, **highest priority** will be given to students in the following circumstances:

- Foster care;
- Housing shared with others due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or similar circumstances;
- Motel/hotel lodging due to lack of other adequate accommodations;
- Emergency or transitional shelter placement; or
- Significant financial need based on individual and/or parent/household income.

All qualified Lexington District One seniors are encouraged to apply. **Applications must be submitted to your high school Counseling and Advisement Office no later than Thursday, March 10, 2022.**

Awards: Grants will be awarded by early May. Funds will help students with their college expenses by providing bedding and typical dorm room supplies, and all items will be purchased by an approved high school staff member. Funds will not be given directly to students; however, the appointed high school staff member may seek input/preferences from each student who receives an award. All purchases should be of good quality, but reasonably priced. Staff will not approve extravagant purchase requests.

The following items that are typically needed in a freshman dormitory may be purchased:

- Extra-long, twin comforter
- 1-2 extra-long twin sheet sets (fitted/flat sheets and pillowcase)
- Bed pillow
- Bath towels, hand towels, and washcloths
- Desk lamp
- Alarm clock
- Laundry basket/hamper
- Curtains
- Clothes hangers
- Storage baskets or stackable crates
- Shower tote and shower shoes/flip flops
- Microwaveable dishes
- Flatware
- Set of plastic drinking glasses
- Water bottle for campus use
- Photo frames or cork board for wall photos
- Desk organizer
- Over-the-door mirror
- Multi-plug power strip/surge protector
- Extra-long twin mattress pad/plastic cover
- Portable fan
- Wall Putty
- Laundry detergent
- Toiletry items – shampoo and conditioner

Any other items needed that are not on the above list must be approved prior to purchase.
