I. Innovation Grants for K-8 Schools

- A. \$25,000 Approved Up to \$5,000 for each grant
- B. Applications Received for 2022-23 School Year
 - 1. Meadow Glen Middle \$4,082.35 Spiking Robotics Across MGES
 - 2. Beechwood Middle \$4,500 3D Printing for the Future
 - 3. Gilbert Middle \$5,000 Outdoor Education Program
 - 4. Pleasant Hill Middle \$4,500 SEL for ALL
- II. Helping Hands Grants To Schools \$76,788 (LEAP Emergency) awarded to all Lexington District One schools in November 2020. Consideration of renewing grant for schools.

III. Grants Update

- A. **Dorm Room Grants** \$20,000 (LEAP Emergency) approved Sept. 2021 to fund 25 Dorm Room Grants (\$300) with Academic Supplement Grants (\$500) for seniors pursuing residential college with significant, documented financial need. Application deadline is March 10, 2022.
- B. **Lexington One Employee Assistance Program** \$50,000 (LEAP Emergency) for up to three years approved to fund program that assists and supports Lexington One employees.
